



DASHING FOOTBALL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Introduction

These terms and conditions govern the participation of your child in the DASHING & VILLARREAL MALAYSIA Football Scholarship Programme. By enrolling your child in the programme, you agree to comply with these terms and conditions.

2. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the scholarship, the child must meet the following criteria:

- **Age:** Participants must be between five (5) and nineteen (19) years old.
- **Financial Need:** The scholarship is designed for underprivileged children from families who demonstrate financial need.
- **Commitment:** Participants are required to commit to regular attendance and active participation in all programme activities.
- **Distance:** Applicants are advised to apply only if they live within a 25 km radius from Villarreal training centres (Footballhub @ Twentyfive.7, Rimbayu, Port Klang (Stadium Mini Datuk Arumugam) for ease of transport.

3. Application Process

Parents or legal guardians must submit a complete scholarship application form on behalf of the child.

Submission of false information may result in disqualification from the programme.

4. Selection Process

Applicants will be evaluated based on financial need, commitment to the programme, and potential for athletic development.

Villarreal Malaysia and Dashing make up the selection committee and their decision is final and not subject to appeal.

The awarding of scholarships to the players is at the sole discretion of the selection committee who reserve the right to reject any application without providing reasons for rejection.



5. Programme Commitments

Participants are expected to attend all training sessions, matches, and other programme-related events unless a valid reason is provided.

They must maintain open and transparent communication with VMA to ensure a clear understanding of the scholarship terms. Seek clarification on renewal criteria, potential risks, and the process for addressing concerns or disputes.

Scholars must only represent Villarreal Malaysia Academy in tournaments and leagues.

Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring the child's punctuality and attendance.

6. Code of Conduct

Participants must adhere to a code of conduct that promotes respect, teamwork, and sportsmanship.

Any form of discrimination, harassment, or unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated.

7. Scholarships and Benefits

The scholarship covers expenses related to training, equipment, and participation in official matches. Additional benefits may be provided at the discretion of Villarreal Malaysia and Dashing.

Please note that the scholarship DOES NOT cover the following:

- Food expenses
- Financial aid or allowance
- Transport costs
- Accommodation or hostel fees
- Primary, secondary, or tertiary education fees

Participants and their parents/guardians are responsible for covering these excluded expenses.



8. Parental Involvement

Parents/guardians are encouraged to actively participate in programme activities, including attending matches and meetings.

9. Termination of Scholarship

The scholarship may be terminated if a participant fails to achieve football grades set by Villarreal Malaysia, fails to comply with programme rules, exhibits unacceptable behaviour, or if false information is discovered in the application.

10. Liability Waiver

Villarreal Malaysia and Dashing is not responsible for any injuries sustained during programme activities. Parents/guardians must ensure that the child is physically fit to participate.

11. Privacy Policy

Personal information collected during the application process will be treated with confidentiality and used solely for programme purposes.

12. Changes to Terms and Conditions

Villarreal Malaysia and Dashing reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time. Parents/guardians will be notified of any changes.

13. Governing Law

These terms and conditions are governed by the laws of Malaysia.

Applications may be submitted by a parent/guardian for children under the age of 18. The parent/guardian verifies that the child meets the criteria and submits the application and forms.
